REMEMBER THIS dueled to the turn, drew off and increased her margin on her own courage. BOP BOP A DO WOP was well placed early, split rivals rallying into the stretch and lugged in a furlong out. AULT STREET ducked out at the start, was outrun to the stretch and split rivals passing tiring rivals. AZASECRET ducked in at the start, dueled early, pressed the pace early on the turn and bore out steadily from midway of the turn to be eight-wide fanning into the stretch. MY DAY WILL COME dueled to the turn and gave way. LADDER raced in the middle of the pack and had no rally. D'OLLHOUSE CAT was pinched back at the start and outrun, and fanned five-wide into the stretch. HOT TEA trailed.
