DEALING LUCKY pressed the pace three-wide, rallied to bid for the lead in the upper stretch and prevailed in a long drive. TORCELLO raced on the outside in the middle of the pack, rallied four-wide on the turn, fanned six-wide moving well into the upper stretch and finished well. OBVIOUSLY TUESDAY pressed the early pace, gained a clear lead midway on the turn, dueled from the upper stretch into the final sixteenth and gave a game effort. HALF A NOTE was slow early, advanced three-wide on the turn and had a mild rally. DIRT DIVER was well placed and had no rally. MIGHTY SCORE sprinted clear and gave way after a half. DADDYS CADDY trailed.
