Footnotes

GOLD PAGEANTRY, broke outward, stalked the leaders from on the hedge, two wide move off far the turn, drew off and held late, driving. HIT ANOTHER GEAR, forced in a bit after the break, settled inside, two wide bid along final turn then closed fast late on the rail. SEPTEMBER HERO, a bit fractious in the gate, was briefly in tight after break, was along the rail closing ground final turn, stumbled badly into the lane when clipping heels of HIT ANOTHER GEAR then closed willingly. RAYNICKS FAN never far back two wide, four wide bid into final turn, closed. CROWN COLONY (GB) up close two wide early, rail run into final turn, faded. MIDSHIP MAMBO quickly to front, gained hedge into first turn, set pace, tired. OORAH settled inside early, never menaced leaders, evenly. BLUE ORAGE pinched back after break, settled inside, three wide into first turn, no bid. LARRY'S FORTY TWO settled three wide into first turn, two wide into lane, no impact. SONNY'S THE ONE prompted pace two wide, gave way final turn, tired.
