DR. KENNEY was unhurried while saving ground, rallied on the inside into the final furlong and quickly drew off. JACOB'S DREAM pressed the pace on the inside, bid for the lead near the final furlong but was no match for the winner although clearly second best. LONSDALE stalked the pace to the final furlong and had no rally. EL MUCHO GRANDE was unhurried early, rallied five-wide into the stretch and finished well. GRAND MAKER steadied into the first turn, trailed to near the stretch and passed tiring rivals. BEGGINFORGIVENESS quickly took command, led to the middle of the stretch and weakened. STORM CLOUDS AHEAD bumped rival into the first turn, rushed to press the pace to the stretch and tired. COMMERSANT bore out badly on the first turn and was outrun. COOLYOURPIPES bore out badly on the first turn and was outrun.
