BLUES SINGER pressed the early pace, dueled for the lead on the turn, gained a short lead into the stretch and drew off under steady urging. JOSIE HOMEMAKER quickly took command, dueled inside the winner to the final sixteenth and weakened. MORE IS BETTER bumped several times with CINDYRELLA while wide and outrun on the backstretch, split rivals rallying into the stretch, came out near that rival again in midstretch and appeared to hit whips with the rider of CINDYRELLA in the final sixteenth. CINDYRELLA bumped with MORE IS BETTER several times in the first quarter-mile, rallied widest into the stretch under right-hand urging, came in a bit toward MORE IS BETTER, the rider switched to left-hand stick and appeared to struck Beaucamp or his whip. PINK GLOSS had brief speed. LADY BANDINI pressed the pace to the turn and gave way. MISS SHOPPIN DIVA was slow early, angled outside of rivals on the backstretch and had no rally.
