SEPTEMBER HERO was unhurried early while well back, made a three wide move into the lane, battled between rivals in mid-stretch then was up under strong urging. SPEEDER was unhurried inside, made a two wide bid along the far turn then battled gamely to the wire. DRINKWATER well placed two wide, made a three wide bid far turn then was forced very wide off that turn and continued with a game finish to no avail. WORDSMITH forced the pace two wide to the far turn, gained a narrow lead, drifted out badly leaving that turn then weakened late. SPEAKING OUT saved ground throughout, made a mild bid into far turn from inside and tired. HORNSHOPE moved out three wide off the first turn, was carried out very wide into the lane and tired. SAND SLIDER raced three wide into the first turn, moved inside off the first turn then was outside into the lane and tired. EYESONWILLIE settled two wide early, gave way into the final turn, tired. PEGASE JEM (FR) narrow advantage setting pace on hedge, empty into lane, tired.
