BO BADGER pressed the pace, angled out rallying into the stretch, challenged for the lead in the upper stretch and drew off under steady urging. DUSTIN' THE REST broke well and rushed to gain command before the first turn, dueled inside MY BAMBINO on the backstretch, drew out on the second turn, responded gamely to the winner's challenge and continued on willingly. ACE IN HAND was unhurried early and passed tiring rivals. EVENFOREVER pressed the early pace, dropped back on the backstretch to stalk the pace and tired in the upper stretch. FLYING APTITUDE trailed to the second turn and passed tiring rivals. MY BAMBINO pressed the pace on the outside to the backstretch, dueled for the lead to the second turn and tired. BECAUSE I WIN raced four-wide on the first turn to stalk the pace to the second turn and gave way into the stretch. SOUTH JAK was outrun. INAGOTABLE was no threat.
