EAGLE BEAGLE settled on the hedge early, moved two wide off the far turn, eased outside rivals in mid-stretch then surged past the leaders in the final jump. IZ was off a step slow, moved up two wide first turn, raced along the rail far turn, led late and gamely missed. CODIGO POSTAL steadied along the first turn from inside, moved out three wide off the far turn, loomed then continued game. ZAPPER forced the pace two wide early, gained the inside along the backstretch, yielded late but stayed on. ON THE LAM three wide into first turn, four wide bid far turn, weakened. STRATEGIC AIM disputed quick pace early, eased out into far turn, bid, weakened. RAGS OLD IRON chased two wide early, no late response, no impact. DJINN SLIPPERS chased two wide throughout, never seriously menaced, no impact. MARK THIS DATE saved ground throughout, no interest until late stretch. CROSSROAD SOUTH in contention three wide, no response far turn, tired.
