TEMPLE LION dueled on the outside to midway of the second turn, drew off near the quarter pole, increased her lead a furlong out and was ridden out. PRECEDENT pressed the pack, couldn't match strides with the winner into the stretch but was up for the place. LUSESITA trailed to the second turn and had a mild rally. SMOOTH CONNECTION was outrun and passed tiring rivals. ROMANOVA dueled for the inside on the inside to the quarter pole and tired. NICKEL C raced in the middle of the pack to the stretch and was eased. STORMYS PROCLIVITY trailed and was eased entering the stretch. RED HEADED GAL pressed the pace on the outside to the second turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
