LORD KYLE'S QUEST stalked leaders from the inside, was two wide leaving the turn then steadily drove clear. MY DIGGER broke inward and brushed the gate to be off a step slow, was hustled inside the make the pace then yielded gamely. NO PASSAGE well placed three wide, was just off inside off the turn then finished evenly stretch. GENERAL EM up close three wide into turn, was carried far out in the stretch run and faded. LEADFOOTXPRESS outrun to turn, two path along turn, no response into stretch. DESERT STONE forced pace two wide into turn, drifted into the lane then continued to drift far out to the outside late stretch while tiring.
