ROUNDUP HAMLET quickly took command, steadily increased her lead into midstretch and then was roused twice in midstretch. SNEAKY LADY was never far back while wide, rallied four-wide on the turn and finished well. ARCHAEOLOGIST dueled early, pressed the pace three-wide between mares to midstretch and weakened. PIRATE FLEET was squeezed back at the start, rushed into contention on the inside and angled inside rallying through the final furlong. GIN GIN trailed and passed tiring rivals. ANARUSA was very fractious in the gate before the start, dueled briefly, was tentatively ridden into the turn, looked for room in the upper stretch but was blocked and then tired. BEACHFRONTPROPERTY ducked in at the start squeezing back PIRATE FLEET, rushed to duel briefly, pressed the pace on the inside, lugged in entering the stretch, her rider went to right-hand backhand whip on her mount's left side, and tired. ROSEMARY'S GAEL was fractious in the gate before the start, pressed the pace between mares to the turn, steadied and tired.
