DREAMING OF JAZZ was fractious in the post parade but stood quietly in the gate, quickly took command, moved quickly when asked entering the stretch and looked like a good horse striding out without urging. MY TWO GREAT KIDS pressed the pace on the inside and was clearly second best. DISCO WRITER pressed the pace, battled between horses near the quarter pole and put in a good effort. RAINBOWAPPEARS rallied four-wide on the turn and tired near the final furlong. LUBICK LUCK pressed the pace three-wide and tired. TONY TILE was fractious before the start and throwing his rider, and trailed.
