ANDY L duelled three-wide into the second turn, quickly drew off under a snug hold and was the easiest kind of winner. SEPTEMBER HERO trailed to the second turn, split rivals rallying into the stretch and finished well. RICHIE RULES pressed the pace on the inside, angled out on the second turn but had no bid. OSTIN'S MIRACLE raced four-wide throughout and passed tired rivals. BECAUSE I WIN pressed the pace into the second turn and tired. QUICK APPEAL duelled for the lead on the first turn, held a short lead at the half-mile pole, battled to the stretch and tired. COBY was outrun. HI IT'S ME duelled between horses to the second and gave way.
