DREAMED A DREAM stalked the leaders into the turn, rallied three-wide into the stretch to gain command before the final furlong and drew off under intermittent urging. MAJESTIC EMILY was unhurried early, rallied on the turn, the jockey headed her toward a hole between fillies in the upper stretch, thought better of it, angled her out four-wide and she had a mild rally. DON SINGS RAMONA stalked the pace on the inside and had a mild rally. CONQUISTADORS ROSE trailed greenly to near the quarter pole and put on an awesome finish between fillies. DOUBLE THE SILK was outrun to midway of the turn and had a mild rally. UNCLE J'S ANGEL dueled on the inside into the stretch and tired. WISE LATINA dueled on the outside into the stretch and tired. FEVERS FULL MOON was outrun. BAY STATE BELLE broke well, ducked out badly and threw her rider. The stewards posted the INQUIRY sign, reviewed BAY STATE BELLE's incident and allowed the result to stand.
