Footnotes

LAST TRAIN BABE chased two wide into turn, raced three wide off the turn then surged late from the outside. TEXAS SHADOW was unhurried three wide, four wide bid into the lane then closed willingly outside the winner. KING MONGO chased from rail early, eased out bit, good finish for share. BREAK THE ICE disputed pace two wide along turn, edged away into lane, weakened. WEST TEXAS off step slow, saved ground into turn, belated response. DIXIE RED chased two wide into turn, three wide into lane, mild bid. HIGH POINT CHARLEY pinched in tight after break, chased in four path, no late impact. TIGER RAMOS contested pace inside along turn, yielded into stretch, tired. MANHATTAN ON ICE in contention inside, couldn't keep pace, tired.
