LAST LAUGH NOW dueled to midway of the second turn, gained a short lead near the quarter pole, drew off into the final furlong and was kept to intermittent urging. HOWARD THE AVIATOR delayed the start while fractious, threw his rider before the start, broke slow, rushed four-wide on the first turn, rallied four-wide on the second turn but couldn't catch the winner. SYMPHONIC HERO dueled for the lead into the second turn, angled out impeding RUNNING WILDCAT approaching the quarter pole and tired in the upper stretch. After a claim of foul by the rider of RUNNING WILDCAT against the rider of LOSTANDFOUNDAGAIN, alleging interference on the second turn, the stewards disqualified SYMPHONIC HERO and placed him fifth. FANEUIL WILDCAT was no threat. RUNNING WILDCAT dueled for the lead to midway of the second turn, was taken up and was done. HE'S A SCROOGE dueled for the lead between horses to the second turn and tired.
