TOMORROWS WILDCAT was quickly clear, showed the way from the inside then kept alert through the stretch. BORACAY WONDER raced in contention inside, saved ground on the turn then continued gamely for the place. LENDING FREEZE bumped after the break, four wide run leaving the turn and closed with a good finish. QUAD'S DOUBLE in contention inside to the turn, raced in the two path off turn but had no impact. OLDE KINGS HIGHWAY bumped after break, chased four wide into turn, bid, faded. MISCOE GRAY chased from inside, no menacing response, weakened. PATRICK N DYLAN off step slow, chased three wide along turn, weakened. SILK SPINNER saved ground chasing leaders, no response, tired. HROSSEY FERRY fractious in gate, up close two wide to turn, faded, empty.
