SHE'S OUT TO LUNCH raced in the middle of the pack, rallied into the stretch and prevailed in a long drive. WINERY pressed the pace, bid for the lead in the upper stretch, drew clear and just missed. JOE'S DOUBLEDANNDI broke well, dropped back, split rivals rallying into the stretch, angled out four-wide and just missed. MISS POSSE quickly took command, steadily increased her lead to the quarter pole, led into the final furlong and weakened. ADELA'S SONG raced in the middle of the pack, rallied on the turn to loom boldly into the stretch but failed to sustain her bid. PULLMEOUT pressed the to midway of the turn and tired. DARN PROUD was outrun. PRAYERS AT MASS had only brief speed.
