NEMO LANDING vied inside along turn, surrendered the lead nearing mid-stretch then came back gamely and was all out. TRIP SIX battled two wide with the winner, narrow lead into lane, grudgingly. COPELAN'S RIDGE chased outside along turn, three wide off turn, bested rest. MR. JOLSON steadied early, chased two wide into turn, evenly, no bid. FIREPOLE lug in start, in close contention outside leaders, faded. TERREMOTICO pinch at break, chased three wide on turn, tired. LIGHT DAYS AHEAD chased from inside to turn, no response into lane, tired. RUSSIAN SAGE bumped very hard break, steadied, chased two wide, tired.
