DANCE FOR ZACK reared up the start, saved ground steadily advancing into the stretch, gained command 80 yards out and drew off under light urging. PRINCESS BEAU K quickly took command, held a clear lead to the final sixteenth, proved no match for the winner but was clearly second best. TEMPLE LION pressed the pace into the stretch and weakened. MARCIANNIE was outrun. SOBER LIVING broke well, steadied behind TEMPLE LION entering the first turn, raced between mares on the backstretch, briefly trailed nearing the second turn, rallied from the three-eighths pole to the final furlong and failed to sustain her bid. An objection by the rider of SOBER LIVING against the rider of TEMPLE LION, alleging interference into the first turn, was not allowed. IMPRACTICAL pressed the pace to the second turn and gave way. SUMMER AT SUSAN'S stumbled at the start and was no threat. FOREST IMP was well placed to the second turn and gave way.
