CLASSIC SPEED dueled outside to the middle of the stretch, drew off and was kept to steady urging. NEWTON CRESCENT pressed the pace and finished well. HOW CONVENIENT trailed to the final furlong, bumped EIGHT CITY TOUR splitting rivals near the final furlong and finished fastest. CHI CHI'S PRIDE raced in the middle of the pack and lacked a late response. SILK SPINNER dueled inside into the final furlong and tired. EIGHT CITY TOUR was outrun early, fanned five-wide into the stretch, bumped a foe and tired. WAIT'N ON SUMTHIN was well placed for a half and tired.
