GRAND TERROR was off a step slow, moved up outside entering the turn, made a five wide move midway on the turn then steadily drove clear. FREE CANDY chased from off the inside to the turn, made a four wide move mid-turn then finished clearly second best. EARLY AGAIN forced the pace three wide into the turn, gained a narrow lead before the quarter-pole then weakened. BEEN A PLEASURE bumped hard break, chased two wide on turn, no menace. GRAND COMMANDER lug in bit break, bumped rival, brief speed near inside, tired. GOLD BID outrun to turn, outside, five path leaving turn, tired. FORT PYRAMID stumbled break, hustled to contest pace two wide, tired. SKIP THE FLIP narrow advantage inside, battled along turn, empty.
