PENITANT PRAYERS vied three abreast to turn, clear from two path off the turn, drifted bit final final furlong and won driving. PAPA CHARLIE four abreast to the turn, chased in the three path off the turn, was carried out a bit late and finished gamely to the wire with no further excuse. SUPERLOOK chased two wide into the turn, along inside into lane, game for share. DUDE AGAIN in close contention four wide into turn, no response lane, faded. GRANBY BOY vied inside winner into turn, weakened into lane. DIGNIFIED ESSENCE moved off inside along turn, three wide into stretch, no impact. PLANT CITY RED in contention two wide into turn, between rivals, tired. SEEKING THE POINT bobbled bit break, hustled three wide into turn, tired. An objection by the rider of PAPA CHARLIE against the winner for alleged interference in the stretch and a subsequent inquiry by the Stewards yielded no change in the order of finish.
