SOLDIER SAM dropped back after a good start, was far back at the quarter pole, came six-wide rallying into the final furlong and had a furious finish to win going away. BIG CASH pressed the early pace, stalked the leader into the stretch, bid for the lead a furlong out, drew clear and missed. ATLANTIC VENTURE threw his head at the start, saved ground steadily advancing and finished well. UNCLE MICKEY was slow early, steadily advanced on the turn to loom boldly near the final furlong and then hung. SILVER MAPLE raced in the middle of the pack and had a mild rally. MOCK ME NOT dueled for the early lead, drew off to a long lead on the turn and weakened in midstretch. GOLDEN GHOST pressed the pace into the stretch and gave way. GAMBLER'S HONOUR was outrun. WICKED MISCHIEF was wide while outrun. MR. B. W. was no threat. PEWTER press the early pace and tired before the turn.
