BILL'S JEWELL unhurried early, three wide run far turn, drove clear outside. MARKSWAYORNOWAY contested pace inside, battled to mid-stretch, held place. COVE BAY chased inside, bid two wide into far turn, drop to rail, traffic. LION'S MADDY attended pace three wide, narrow advantage stretch, weakened. SPECIAL JAK in contention near inside, rail into far turn, eased out, faded. OUR DREAMETTE settled two wide, rail into final turn, no menacing bid. CAJUN BELLE outrun inside, no menacing speed, no impact. POPULAR ACT forced pace two wide, no response into lane, tired.
