BRENNAN D held a narrow lead into the turn, edged away from along the rail then surged clear under strong urging. STAR OF COLLEEN L. chased two wide, eased out in upper stretch and closed gamely for the place. MISSSTORMYATLANTIC pressed the winner early, loomed a serious threat to deep stretch but was outfinished late. CINNAMON SECRET was off a step slow, was saving ground on the turn but had no late punch. SLIPSHOE three wide chasing leaders, lacked closing response. BEAUTIFUL BECKE settled inside, failed to seriously menace leaders. DIMPLED CHAD off slow, hustled into contention inside rivals, weakened. WHOSIS in contention two wide, couldn't keep pace, faded. KNOCK OUT PROSPECT off slow, never involved saving ground. HONOUR chased outside, no factor.
