MY MA B raced in mid pack, was four wide into the lane and finished willingly. ORIENTAL QUEEN was away alertly, allowed to settle into stride, raced four wide into the stretch and lacked a late response. GINGER LEMON failed to threaten in a ground-saving trip. KISS ME YOU FOOL pressed the early pacesetter, assumed command at the quarter pole and tired shortly thereafter.
