Footnotes

SILK SPINNER was away alertly, began to advance on the turn, drifted out in mid stretch and drew clear late. GOLD STAR DANCER void of early foot, angled out eight wide into the lane and showed a big late run. SILKS SOLOTUDE was unhurried early and finished well between horses. MISCOE GRAY was never far back, offered a bid in mid stretch but failed to find the necessary late response. SOCIANO'S LEGACY broke sharply, vied for the lead while racing two wide and weakened in late stretch. LADDER raced mid pack, offered a bid with an eighth of a mile to run but lacked a strong closing kick. DEBLUE was allowed to settle into stride early and improved his position. SOCIANO'S REWARD raced mid pack early and failed to menace. ROSEMARY'S GAEL failed to threaten. MISS TADOR dropped back early, showed no rally and was outrun. KNUTE dueled briefly along the inside and stopped.
