HOWARD THE AVIATOR steadied into the first turn, split rivals entering the second turn, drew clear near the furlong pole and was under light urging. SYMPHONIC HERO sprinted clear, responded gamely on the second turn but couldn't stay with the winner. MR. ROESSINK broke well to gain the rail, tired entering the second turn and passed tiring rivals. GIMMEADRINK stalked the pace three-wide to the stretch and tired. MONSIGNOR NUGENT was outrun. LEOPOLIS showed nothing. DUSTIN' THE REST stalked the pace between horses to the second turn, tired and was eased.
