Footnotes

NANA'S TOY advanced into tight quarters along the inside entering the far turn, angled out for room then ran clear from the outside through late stretch. RADON DANCER moved three wide into the far turn to vie for command and faltered. LAST SLED DOWN steadied behind rivals around the first turn, moved three wide between rivals into the far turn to vie, came in some midway on the turn, dueled inside through the lane and faltered. FORTUNATE SMILE was carried out into the first turn, steadied in tight between rivals entering the far turn and continued evenly. AUNT RUTHIE cleared early inside, was steadied then clipped heels and stumbled midway on the final turn, bore out nearing the stretch and stopped. COUNTERSTEP was outrun. ESKIMO MOM ran out entering the first turn then was outrun. An objection by Molinari against the third finisher was not allowed.
