Footnotes

COOL HEART pressed the pace on the outside into the backstretch, moved up three-wide to duel for the lead, drew off on the second turn, held a clear lead into the final furlong and was kept to steady urging. UP MARKET raced in the middle of the pace, rallied on the second turn to loom boldly near the final furlong then lugged in the rest of the race. MEDIEVAL SWORD was unhurried early, rallied four-wide on the second turn and finished well. EL MUCHO GRANDE raced in the middle of the pace to the second turn, rallied into the stretch to loom boldly a furlong out and then weakened. FESTIVO was fractious in the post parade, injuring his rider, reared at the start, saved ground and had a mild rally. ELECTRO BEAT pressed the pace on the inside into the second turn and weakened. JACOB'S DREAM dueled for the lead into the second turn and tired. IRON POST was outrun. ACERE was far back to the stretch and finished well. BEST AND FINAL dueled for a half and tired.
