TRIP SIX duelled on the outside, drew off before the quarter pole, steadily increased his lead to the middle of the stretch and was kept to light urging. MISFIT MANNY trailed for three furlongs, rallied four-wide into the stretch, couldn't catch the winner but was clearly second best. GROUP EFFORT pressed the pace and gave way before the quarter pole. FIRE KING had speed to the turn and gave way. OBVIOUSLY TUESDAY duelled inside to the middle of the turn and gave way. FOUR F'S AND A D was through early.
