NORTHERN DUKE quickly in front, set pace from rail, vigorous urging lane. COPELAN'S RIDGE in contention inside, two wide run off turn, no match late. OORAH chased two wide into turn, along rail off turn, finished well. SIR CLASSIC CHRIS chased three wide into turn, for wide off turn, evenly late. EL QUIXOTE pressed pace two wide into turn, loomed into lane, faded. FIFTY SEVEN G in contention two wide, three wide off turn, no late impact. PERSONAL COPY chased three wide early, no menacing response, tired. S. M. W. KAITLYN saved ground chasing leaders, gave way into lane, tired.
