OXFORD LASS pressed the pace, angled out three-wide into the stretch, lugged in gaining control a furlong out, drew off and was easing in the late yards. MIMI'S SUGAR dueled for a half, held a brief lead into the stretch, proved no match for the winner but was second best. ROBYNSPERFECTDANCR was outrun early, saved ground into the stretch, angled out in the upper stretch and had a mild rally. ARBELLE raced outside in the middle of the pack, split rivals five-wide into the stretch and had a mild rally. GANZA was outrun while wide, went three-wide on the turn, fanned seven-wide into the stretch and showed nothing. HOLY WINE was slow early, rallied on the backstretch, went four-wide at the three-eighths pole outside GANZA, was herded eighth-wide when that one fanned into the stretch and tired. MISS PASCO COUNTY dueled for the lead on the outside to the stretch and gave way. TRUE CHICK had brief speed, gave way and was eased in the final furlong.
