FUNNY DANCE settled outside, five wide run into lane, surged clear, driving. DAYTONA BOUND moved two wide into turn, angled inside late stretch, game. THE LION CLYDE in contention inside, three wide bid off turn, outfinished late. CLASSIC GUY well placed two wide, four wide leaving turn, loomed, faded. BOLD DREAM off slow, chased just off rail, belated response. WENTWORTH chased three wide into turn, no response into lane, weakened. INDA EASTER PARADE outrun inside, never reached leaders, no bid. EL TIBURON forced pace two wide, narrow lead into lane, tired. EXCHANGE THE LIMIT hustled inside, gave way into stretch, tired.
