TOUCH slow early, moved five wide into the turn, rallied outside into deep stretch and drove clear. WANNA KAT moved up the inside, proved no match for the winner and finished second best. DEVIL SMILES assumed a short advantage, moved to a clear advantage into the stretch and faltered in the drive. HUCKSTER'S GIRL made a run along the rail around the turn, weakened into the stretch. PRINCESS GINA advanced outside, weakened into the stretch. FARMA'S MARKET chased outside, wide around turn, failed to threaten. RIP ROARING RHYTHM was never a threat. DUE NATION chased outside, tired. YOUR SO CHARMING up close and outside, moved to rail turn, tired. LOT O' CURRENCY away slow, never a factor. JANINES SECRET chased outside, tired.
