**Footnotes**

NOA'S TOY stalked in hand early, was boxed in heading into the final turn, moved out two wide midway along that turn, wore down the leader inside the furlong marker then steadily drew off. LADY IRENE prompted the pace from the inside, battled with winner to midstretch and yielded in the final furlong. SHOUT, well placed four wide, loomed into the stretch and gradually weakened. LAKESHORE was never too far back and two wide into the final turn, came in in a rival into that turn then tired. CANONDALE settled inside, stalked in contention, steadied while in tight on the rail into the far turn then gave way and steadied again in midstretch while not a threat. TRICKY'S GAL slow into stride early, outrun off rail, improved position. OVERTIMEANGIE BABY contested early pace two wide, gave way leaving final turn, tired. PROCYON three wide early, never seriously involved. LIVERMORE DREAM off step slow, chased four wide early, empty final turn. HAWAIIIN FROLIC five wide early, briefly in contention, stopped. An objection by the rider of CANONDALE against the rider of LAKESHORE for alleged interference into the far turn was dismissed.
