BAY STATE BELLE duelled on the outside into the stretch, drew off to a clear lead and was hard urged to last. PATS LOVE pressed the pace on the inside, rallied into the stretch and was getting to the winner with every stride. WILD SCHOHARIE was never far back, bid three-wide into the stretch, couldn't match strides with the top pair through the stretch and lugged in late. TORI N JOEY'S ROSE raced four-wide in the middle of the pack, angled in near the stretch but lacked a rally. ESTHER IRON CROSS duelled for the lead on the inside into the stretch and gave way. WHYLEE showed nothing. BEACHFRONTPROPERTY trailed to stretch. ROSEMARY'S GAEL raced three-wide into the first turn, pressed the pace to the second turn and gave way.
