KING'S MISSILE stalked leader just off inside, rallied inside into lane, driving. ROBBIE'S EXPRESS settled two wide early, three wide into far turn, gamely. WELCOME BACK saved ground early, two wide into lane, evenly stretch. INDY WORLD unhurried early, three wide bid into stretch, good finish. KING'S CORONATION chased just off inside, four wide into far turn, bid, outfinished. BRIDLE WAY BAY two wide into first turn, saved ground into stretch, no punch. UNLIMITEDCASH chased two wide early, five wide bid into far turn, faded. LOQUACIOUS LOVER sent to command early, pace to quarter-pole, tired.
