E. J. LITTLE BOY contested pace two wide, drew off leaving the turn and was kept to a steady drive. MO DULAR in close contention inside, angled out the leaving turn and finished gamely late. CLASSIC SPEED bobbed at the break, rushed inside, stayed on well late but lost the place. RICHIE'S O KAY outrun to stretch, outside bid into the lane and had some late interest. GENESIS ONE well placed three wide, faded leaving the turn, tired. DUBAI EMINENCE chased two wide into turn, no menacing response, tired.
