APPEALING YANKEE hit the gate, appeared to throw a shoe forty yards from the start, rushed to gain a clear lead at the half-mile pole, drew off to a long lead into the final furlong and was given a vigorous hand ride while his margin rapidly diminished. BOB'S PLACE was fractious just before the start and hesitated, steadily advanced and finished very well. GIMMEONEMORE raced in the middle of the pack while outrun to the final furlong and rallied. COCKEYED ROOSTER stumbled at the start, rushed to take a brief lead, raced in closest attendance to the final furlong and tired. J J CALI pressed the pace into the turn and weakened. LET IT BE HARDYBOY was outrun. MY BROTHER CHUCK had brief speed and went five-wide into the stretch. WAX ON WAX OFF showed nothing. CODE TAKER trailed and went eight-wide in the stretch. THE STEWARDS POSTED THE INQUIRY SIGN, REVIEWED THE START AND ALLOWED THE RESULT TO STAND.
