**Footnotes**

BIG MAHOGANY rushed to gain a short lead to the turn, steadily increased his lead to midstretch and was kept to strong urging. FREGATA was slow early, rushed to race in the middle of the pack, angled out rallying into the stretch and finished well. DAYTONA BOUND dueled three-wide to the turn, pressed the winner's pace into midstretch and weakened a bit. PRIMAL HUMOR trailed to the turn, saved ground advancing into the stretch and finished well. WINTHROP HOUSE was outrun early, rallied six-wide into the stretch but lacked a late response. DOUBLE DEVILISH stalked the pace five-wide into the stretch, had a mild rally in the upper stretch but failed to sustain his bid. ROBBIE'S EXPRESS raced in the middle of the pack and had no rally. COPELAN'S RIDGE dueled between horses into the turn and weakened. GO ANGEL GO showed nothing. MO DULAR dueled four-wide into the turn, gave way badly and was eased.
