GIMMEADRINK steadied and angled out into the first turn, steadily advanced while angling to the rail, moved quickly into the second turn, angled out three-wide bidding for the lead at the quarter pole, gained command under four right-hand whips in the final furlong and drew off. SYMPHONIC HERO duelled for the lead on the outside for a half, drew off to a clear lead on the second turn, responded gamely to the winner's bid and fought to the final sixteenth. COMMERSANT was well placed, split rivals moving well into the upper stretch but failed to sustain his bid. MR. ROESSINK was outrun to the second turn, had a mild rally into the stretch but couldn't threaten. MARSHALL raced evenly in the middle of the pack. RUNNING WILDCAT raced in the middle of the pack, had a mild rally on the second turn and weakened. MY BAMBINO was outrun. BO BADGER was not a threat. FRANKIE RULES duelled for the lead into the second turn and gave way.
