### Footnotes

DANIA BAY inherited the lead while on the rail into the first turn, set the pace into the stretch and was fully extended to prevail. CASA NEKIA raced in close contention saving ground, loomed two wide off the far turn then finished gamely. KIMSTER settled off the rail, rallied three wide into the stretch and continued gaining late. INTERNATIONAL CITY saved ground first turn, closed the gap along rail into the lane but hung inside the final furlong. DEERWOOD LASS was unhurried early, saved ground along the far turn but had no late impact. PLINKING raced in contention two-three wide, gave way from the outside and weakened. THE BIG UGLY was two wide into the first turn, faded three wide off the far turn and weakened. WIRED N READY bore out heading into the first turn, was getting out along the backstretch then was pulled up before entering the final turn.
