TWO DRAGONS stalked pace two wide, drove clear into stretch, steady drive. OORAH well placed inside, in tight briefly into far turn, game second. AMBRAW assumed command just off inside, set pace to far turn, weakened. O'KID two wide early, rail run final turn, evenly stretch run. DADSFOURWHEELDRIVE in contention two wide, outside early, couldn't keep pace, tired. WHEELY three wide chasing leaders, no response into lane, tired.
