RED HOT STAR was soon clear, set the pace along the rail under rating then drew off while being kept alert through the stretch run. BUTTONWOOD IDA, in contention two wide, battled between rivals along the turn then was along late for the place. HOT JELLY JAM chased from the inside, battled inside the runner up through the final furlong and weakened. LAURA'SLUCKYCHARM was off a step slow, was three wide chasing into the turn and weakened. I'M NOT CRAZY forced the early pace, was two wide into the turn then gradually gave way in upper stretch. CALLING off step slow, chased saving ground, tired. WAVERING MARCI in contention to turn, three wide, tired. MT. ST. PATTY chased five wide into turn, no response, tired. BALLADO MELODY well placed four wide early, tired leaving turn.
