BISHOP OF NOLA was unhurried into the second turn, rallied four-wide into the stretch, bore out in midstretch and drew off under strong urging. SIR TAYPOT quickly took command on the inside, was well handled, responded well when challenged at the quarter pole, drew off into the final furlong and gave a game effort. BROKEN SOUND pressed the pace on the inside into the second turn, angled out three-wide bidding for the lead and continued on well. COVE STAR was outrun to the second turn and finished well. VAN LEROY saved ground in the middle of the pack, rallied inside to the stretch and tired. CHILLIN DYLAN was well placed to the second turn, bid for the lead near the quarter pole to the final furlong and was soon done. HELLO D. NGATA showed nothing. FANEUIL WILDCAT trailed. GANDOLFO pressed the pace to the second turn, gave way and was pulled up.
