TARRANTULA stalked the early pacesetter, moved to command leaving the far turn and proved best, driving. BLAZE COQUETTE trailed early, rallied into deep stretch and just failed. DAISY BE GOOD was away slow, made up some ground into deep stretch, too late. ANT SAMI up close and outside, weakened in the drive. WITCHES ROSE was wide into the first turn and wide around the far turn. AMPITA moved up the inside, weakened into deep stretch. DOVEENA assumed a short advantage, gave way when challenged. HUSH DOTTIE moved up the inside, tired into the stretch. LUCKY FOLLY wide into first turn, wide around far turn, tired.
