JOE DENUCCI angled inside after the start to stalk the pace, rallied well into the final furlong and responded to steady urging to be up a sixteenth out. DANLY'S DREAM rated early, advanced inside on the backstretch, angled out four-wide rallying on the second turn, held a short lead into the stretch and weakened a sixteenth out. EAST INDIES was outrun early, saved ground gaining into the stretch, angled out four-wide near the final furlong and finished well. DOUBLE DANCER quickly took command, led to the stretch and tired in the final furlong. ZAJAL trailed to the second turn, advanced between horses on the second turn but lacked a late response. SMARTER STILL was well placed for a half and tired. ETHAN JOHN pressed the pace four-wide on the first turn, pressed the pace three-wide on the second turn and tired in the final furlong. LITTLE JAKE was well placed three-wide on the first turn, remained prominent into the second turn and gave way. VINNY THE EMPEROR stalked the pace five-wide on the first turn and gave way after a half.
