Footnotes

WHEELY pressed the pace three-wide to the second turn, dueled on the outside entering the stretch, gained a very short lead a furlong out and was all out to last under strong urging. DOMESTIC AFFAIR quickly took command, responded gamely when challenged entering the stretch and alternated the lead to the final step, just missing. FERBER steadied in tight quarters entering the first turn, steadily advanced, angled out in the stretch and finished well while rapidly getting the leaders. MONSIGNOR NUGENT trailed to the second turn, split rivals in the upper stretch and finished well. UNFLAPABLE dwelt, was outrun to the second turn, had a mild advance to the stretch and gave way. RICHIE RULES raced wide in the middle of the pack and tired. SCHOOL BOY HEART pressed the pace into the second turn, bore out on the second turn and was soon done. UNBRIDLED DEVIL was well placed for three furlongs, gave way and was eased.
